God is blessing the work here and I am so excited about how the Lord has been using His Word to touch people's lives. I have had the opportunity to visit several families near our home. We sit at a table, or stand under a tree, drinking coffee and at some point during our conversations; God opens the door so that I may share the gospel message with them.
